Apple flowering times can be divided into five periods.

Early flowering (F 1)

Early to mid-season (F 2) Mid-season (F 3)

Mid to late (F 4)

Late flowering (F 5)

Similarly, different apple varieties have different picking times.

These are given as a guide only and actual picking date will often vary slightly from these times

Early (P 1) January

Second early (P 2) Feb

Mid (P 3) March - mid April

Late (P 4) Mid April - May

Very late (P 5) June

Triploid versus Diploid

“Triploid” apples have a different genetic makeup to “diploid” apples. The relevance is in choosing varieties for cross pollination. Triploid apples can receive pollen from a diploid apple flowering at the same time, but cannot donate pollen in return. Therefore at least 2 diploid varieties need to be present to pollinate each other, as well as the triploid apple.
